

The Magister Lvcentinvs offers a one-year LLM and three Specialist Qualifications Diplomas in Patents and Technology Transfer; Trademarks, Designs and Competition Law; and Copyright and Information Technology. Throughout the year it also offers special courses, including the well-known Intensive Course on Community Trade Marks and Designs, or the ITIP UPDATE Seminars, which are open to IP practitioners eager to deepen their knowledge in various relevant issues.

We are proud to be a founding member of the European Intellectual Property Institutes Network (EIPIN), which brings together IP students, scholars, and professionals in a permanent debate forum enabling them to discuss the latest topics in this subject area. Among other activities, EIPIN organizes two international seminars every year.

During the academic year, our students learn the National, European and International Intellectual Property Systems in highly orientated practical sessions that are delivered in both Spanish and English. The academic faculty includes more than a hundred and fifty national and international lecturers, all of whom are renowned specialists in their respective fields. Leading academic and professional institutions across the world collaborate with the University of Alicante on the course, including the Office for the Harmonization in the Internal Market, the European Patent Office, the World Intellectual Property Organization, and the Spanish Patent and Trademarks Office.
